





GREENS & GROUNDS



I hope everyone has been enjoying the past few weeks of what is officially summer even though the temperatures have not dictated that yet. The Greens and Grounds team has been pushing to deliver great conditions week after week. As the summer heat and stress begin to build into the summer months, we will continue to monitor our maintenance practices and make adjustments as needed to protect the course throughout the summer.

As mentioned above, adjustments to our maintenance practices may consist of raising mowing heights,

decreasing our frequency of rolling, or light and frequent watering (syringing) of the turf to cool the leaf. With the potential maintenance adjustments, you might see green speeds slow slightly or playing surfaces become slightly softer, as some of these are due to mechanical inputs, mother nature does play a role as well. Greens will get "sticky" since the grass is perspiring trying to cool itself. We will also be applying more water to the turf as we can lose as much as .25" of moisture a day during hotter days; more water will also contribute to softer playing surfaces.

Over the coming weeks, we will perform small tine aerification on the greens to help increase oxygen to the root zone and surface drainage during any wet periods while helping to alleviate compaction from our daily mowing and rolling practices. We will also begin to do light

topdressing on tees and greens to help reduce any scalping from mowers. During the summer, the turf begins to get spongy or "puffy" as we call it, and the sand will help reduce this effect. Also, during the hotter days this summer, you may see some of my staff on playing surfaces checking soil moisture or watering; if you should see them, please give them a few moments to move out of the way and you can continue on your round.




As of June 23rd we had officially completed our new Rainbird irrigation system. With any new piece of

equipment or project, we typically have some growing pains and will see the same with this as well. With 1,916 individually controlled head and/or electric block zone areas we will have minor adjustments to make on a daily basis. The daily operation of the new system can be done remotely from any connected device. You might see my assistants and myself running the new system from a phone or tablet. The system is able to provide us with a lot of data from weather and rainfall totals to accurate voltage readings from individual irrigation heads. With the increase in the data given to us, it will allow us to make more accurate decisions and begin to be more proactive than reactive.

You may have seen the posts with a small white catch can on them near #12 tee and #5 tee. These devices will monitor rainfall total and deliver data to the irrigation system. This data can then get analyzed for that area of the golf course and make real-time adjustments of irrigation run times or total shutdowns automatically should we receive rain during the day or at night. These adjustments are made dependent on the parameters that I set. As my team begins to learn the system and make the adjustments over time, course conditions will increase and become more uniform.

Please continue to enjoy the course and during your round, please do your part in fixing ball marks and divot filling throughout the year. The Greens and Grounds team appreciates your efforts along with your fellow members.
