GREENS & GROUNDS



The weather so far this year has been relatively mild temperatures with minimal rainfall this spring. Rainfall events seem to have brought us a lot or nothing. With our irrigation system project coming to an end, we have seen a good response from the course and our ability to apply water across the property.

The last steps in the completion of the irrigation project are the clubhouse lawns, main entranceway, punch list, and decommissioning of the old irrigation system. Tanto Irrigation should be off-site within the next few weeks. The Greens and Grounds team will then be able to focus on the golf course and make sure we are ready for the summer.

As we get into the heart of the season, I wanted to pass along the weekly and monthly maintenance schedule my staff strives to complete, ultimately creating the best golf experience.

Great River Greens and Grounds Maintenance Schedule

I. Greens mowed daily under normal weather conditions

II.Greens rolled 3-4 times per week

III.Greens sprayed weekly with fertilizer, plant protectants, and growth regulators

IV.Greens moisture is monitored daily, creating more consistent putting surfaces V.Collars, approaches, tee's, fairways, and practice facilities mowed twice per week

VI.Rough mowed and maintained around 2.5" weekly

VII.Tee and Pin locations changed 5-7 times per week depending on rounds played

VIII.Tees, approaches, and fairways are sprayed bi-weekly with fertilizer, plant protectants, and growth regulators

IX.Bunkers raked 5-7 times per week, dependent on rounds played

X. Weekly hand trim of bunker edges, trees, and other obstructions

XI.Edge Irrigation heads and yardage markers monthly

XII.Driving range, short-game, and tee divots filled weekly

XIII.Preventative weed and insect control 3-4 times per growing season


XIV.Granular fertility - 2 times per season on most turf surfaces

XV. Clubhouse grounds are cared for on a daily basis

These are many of the tasks we strive to accomplish in a week over the 150-acre property to provide the best possible conditions to you. Please do your part to assist in keeping our course in great shape through the summer by fixing ball marks and filling your divots with the mix provided on the carts. When repairing a divot we recommend using the mix provided on the carts vs the replacement of the grass pelt. Typically, the replacement of the pelt will dry out and die in the summer heat or get blown off the fairway from our blowers the following morning.
